Re: Tuberculin Skin Testing

The State of New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services requires that all teachers and other school employees who have more than 20 hours of indoor contact with students have a tuberculosis skin test upon employment. Any new employee with a documented negative Mantoux within the last six months, or a positive Mantoux regardless of when it was done, is exempt from this testing. Also, if you have a documented Mantoux and are transferring from another district, you do not need to be tested.

A copy of such documentation will be needed for your employee file. *If you do not have a private medical physician you may contact any Minute Clinic including one conveniently located in Denville at 276 East Main Street. An appointment is not necessary. Generally the hours for the Minute Clinic are Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m., Saturday 9:00 to 5:30 and Sunday 9:00 to 4:30.* The charge for administering the test is \$28.00. Testing must be done prior to start date. Additionally, please note you must return back to the clinic or have our nurse read the results within 48 to 72 hours.
