Join us on June 19th at 10:00am as Lauren Blaszak and Monica Osgood present together strategies and techniques to use with your child during challenging times.

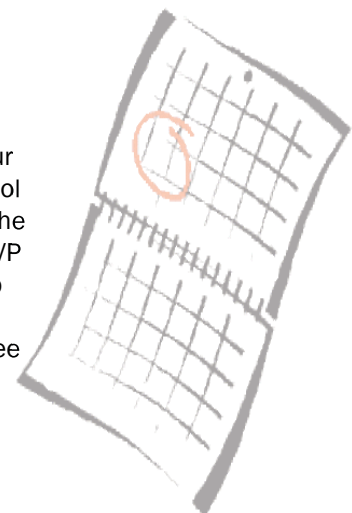
